HOT SHOT COMPETITION RULES:

1. Competition will be conducted using the basket height, and foul line distance, as stated in the normal division rules of play.
2. Two teams will shoot at opposite baskets at the same time.
3. Each round is two minutes in duration.
4. Teams will line up their players behind the foul line.
5. Teams will rotate through every player in a sequence determined by the team until all have shot and then repeat that order until time expires. The team may set up a different order each round.
6. One player from each team attempts a single foul shot, then moves to the back of the line.
7. One coach may stand in the paint and rebound shots and pass the ball to the next player.
8. **SECOND BALL/SECOND COACH RULE:** A second ball is provided, in the event a shot gets away from the basket. Only one ball can be in play at a time. A second coach is allowed. They may (a) Retrieve errant balls or (b) replace the coach or ball in the paint while the other coach retrieves the ball. *Two coaches should not be in the paint at the same time and two balls should not in the paint/around the foul line at any time.*

Scoring: Each successful basket is 1 point. Each team will have two rounds to shoot, against different teams if possible. Combined number of points for two rounds will determine any rankings/winners. Head-to-Head competition will be maintained for tie-breaker purposes only.

Tiebreaker:

1. In the event a tie for awards. Each team will be awarded one point for each of the two head-to-head competitions.
2. If there is still a tie, there will be a one (1) minute overtime period. High score wins.
3. If there is still a tie, there will be a thirty (30) second overtime period. High score wins.
4. If there is still a tie, teams will select one representative for a game of rock/paper/scissors. Best two out of three wins.
